Initiation of Return to Work Canvass

As noted in the communication issued earlier today, the following outlines the process for the return to work canvass as Lehigh Valley Operations (LVO) prepares to resume production on Monday, May 11, 2020.

LVO in partnership with UAW Local 677 Leadership has agreed on a manpower plan that ensures we return employees to the workplace in a safe manner, while incorporating the required social distancing measures. We will first offer a canvass for volunteers to fill the initial manpower needs. If we are unable to meet those needs, we will proceed with a recall of junior employees by either skill set or area.
